



NON COMPLIANT CRIB WARRANTY POLICY

On **December 28, 2010**, new federal standards were announced that mandate any crib provided by child care facilities, family child care homes, hotels, or other public places of use, must meet new and more stringent federal safety standards by December 28, 2012.

By Law, no crib can be sold after June 28, 2011, that is not compliant to the new standards, 16 CFR 1219 or 16 CFR 1220. Please understand that non-compliant cribs (cribs that are not compliant to these new mandated standards) may remain in service until December 28, 2012. After this date, it is unlawful to use a crib not compliant to the new standard.

As a result of the new federal laws, Foundations will stop producing replacement parts for non-compliant cribs on June 28, 2011. For as long as replacement parts exist, Foundations will continue to service cribs until the December 28, 2012 deadline.

In the event that a consumer has a warranty on a non-compliant crib that needs a replacement part, which Foundations no longer has in stock, Foundations will satisfy that warranty claim with a replacement product of equal or greater value. This will be accomplished through a prorated warranty in which the consumer may purchase a new crib at a discount equal to the remaining useful life of the crib. This will be calculated based on the manufacture date code printed on the crib. In this event the consumer must take out of service and dispose of the original crib. Details and pricing will be provided by Foundations Customer Service.

If the consumer has an out of warranty crib in need of a replacement part, we will sell that part (if available) through December 28, 2012. If the requested part is not available, the consumer must dispose of the crib and replace with a new, compliant crib, purchased at regular price.
